1. GENERAL: THIS RVN FREQUENCY PUBLICATION IS DESIGNED FOR QUICK REFERENCE TO EMERGENCY PROCEDURES, FLIGHT FOLLOWING SERVICES, ARTILLERY ADVISORIES, AND LIMITED AIRFIELD FACILITY FREQUENCIES.

3. REQUEST FORMAT: INDIVIDUAL UNITS UTILIZING THIS PUBLICATION SHOULD SUBMIT A REQUEST IN WRITING TO THE ADDRESS ABOVE AND INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - a) COMPLETE UNIT MAILING ADDRESS
 - b) TOTAL NUMBER OF COPIES REQUIRED
4. THIS WILL BE THE LAST ISSUE OF THE RVN FREQUENCY PUBLICATION. THE INFORMATION CONTAINED HEREIN IS AVAILABLE IN THE DOD FLIP PUBLICATIONS AND ELSEWHERE. COMMANDERS SHOULD INSURE THAT THEIR UNITS ARE ON THE DISTRIBUTION LIST FOR THOSE PUBS.
5. NOTICE: THIS FREQUENCY PUBLICATION TAKES SEVERAL WEEKS TO REACH THE FIELD ONCE IT HAS BEEN SENT IN FOR PRINTING. THEREFORE, IT CANNOT BE 100% ACCURATE UPON RECEIPT. THIS HEADQUARTERS SOLICITS YOUR INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE BY SUBMITTING A NOTICE OF CORRECTIONS, ADDITIONS AND/OR DELETIONS WHICH WOULD INCREASE THE ACCURACY AND EFFICIENCY OF THIS PUBLICATION. THIS INFORMATION SHOULD BE SUBMITTED DIRECTLY TO THE ADDRESS SHOWN IN PARAGRAPH 2.
6. NOTE: DUE TO A LIMITED FLIGHT FOLLOWING SYSTEM NECESSITATED BY STANDDOWNS AND THE SHORTAGE OF PERSONNEL IN RVN, IT WILL BECOME THE INCREASING RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH AVIATOR TO USE ANY AND ALL MEANS AVAILABLE TO HIM, SUCH AS MACV NETS, ARTILLERY ADVISORY NETS, AND AIR-TO-AIR COMMUNICATION WITH OTHER AIRCRAFT, TO SUPPLEMENT THE FLIGHT FOLLOWING SYSTEM NOW IN EFFECT. FLIGHT FOLLOWING SERVICES WILL CONTINUE TO DECLINE AS US FORCES CONTINUE WITHDRAWAL AND IN ANTICIPATION OF THIS, EACH AVIATOR WILL NEED TO APPLY MORE INITIATIVE AND RESOURCEFULNESS TO OBTAIN FLIGHT FOLLOWING.
7. WARNING: IT HAS BEEN THE EXPERIENCE OF THIS HEADQUARTERS THAT AVIATORS WHO RELY UPON ARTILLERY ADVISORIES FROM FLIGHT FOLLOWING CENTERS HAVE BEEN FLYING THROUGH "HOT" AREAS. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH AVIATOR TO CONTACT THE LOCAL AREA ARTILLERY ADVISORY NET AS PUBLISHED BY MR ON PAGES 5 THROUGH 8 IN ORDER TO REMAIN CLEAR OF ACTIVE ARTILLERY FIRE.
